Maundy Thursday, April 14, 7:30 pm - Hannah Marks will join Tom and Pastor MB in worship leadership that evening.

Sometime in June during Sunday worship - We will hold an outdoor picnic/ celebration worship service that will feature a Praise and Worship band! Band soon to be announced...!

Friday - Saturday, October 7 - 8 - Choral Festival!!!! Composer soon to be announced...!

First Sunday in Advent, November 27, 10 - 11 am - Long-time Old Greenwich Church friends and beautiful classical guitar duo, Michael Newman and Laura Oltman, will lead us in Advent music during worship.

Welcome to worship at Old Greenwich Presbyterian Church!

We are so glad you are worshipping with us — whether in-person or online! (We will continue to offer online services even as we gather in person).

As our children under 12 and some adults are not able to be vaccinated at this time, we are committed to keeping our whole community safe and thriving. As such, if you are worshipping with us in person, the following are required:

PROTOCOLS FOR INSIDE/SANCTUARY WORSHIP:

Masks must be worn at all times inside the building;

Please enter through the Green Room, which is also handicapped accessible, at the beginning of worship. You may exit through any of our doors after worship;

Social distance is to be maintained between non-family members;

Please sign in (one of our ushers will help with that);

An usher will hand you a printed bulletin if you choose to use one. Please deposit the bulletin in a waste can as you leave; There will be no singing or spoken liturgical responses (such as the Lord's Prayer);

We will not pass offering plates. Please drop off your offering as you exit the sanctuary

During Communion Sundays (first Sundays of the month), you may either bring your own bread/juice, or obtain a pre-packaged wafer/cup from an usher;

If you use the restrooms, please follow the instructions (posted in all bathrooms) by either using ProKure and/or Clorox wipes (provided in all bathrooms);

When fellowship is offered, you may pick up food and/or drinks in Memorial Hall, but we encourage you to go outside for eating and fellowshipping;

As we want to keep the air moving and ventilated as much as possible (which will include some open doors and windows), keeping that in mind as you dress for worship;

If you are feeling ill in any way, please join us virtually.



PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN

We are planning to begin a new study on **Tuesday, February 15, at 11:30 am**, live in the church in



the room behind the pastor's office in Trinity Wing. We'll meet the third Tuesday of each month. We could Zoom you if you're not up to in -person meetings. There are nine lessons, but other than the two chapters on Mary, one woman is lifted up and you could drop in when you're free and not worry about continuity. The authors DVD will be used and introduces each session.

What My Grandmothers Taught Me; Learning from the women in Matthew's Genealogy of Jesus the PW study written by Merryl Blair will be used. Here's a glimpse: "people hade often been intrigued by the appearance of five women in the genealogy of Jesus. Explore who these women are, discover their stories, examine the challenges and choices they faced, and consider what contributions each made to the ancestral line of Jesus. In the process, hear the author's invitation to learn from their example and be inspired to call on God to empower our own witness and action despite challenging circumstances in our own times."

"What do the following women have in common? A woman who acted as a prostitute to be faithful to her family, a prostitute, a foreign immigrant, a woman 'taken' for a man's sexual pleasure, an unwed mother who flees as a refugee."

Yep, they are in the bible, in the genealogy. If you never looked at them as was just described, come let's investigate those claims together.

You're invited to bring a picture of a family wedding, a picture of your grandma or woman of another generation who made a difference in your life, an old church cookbook or grandma's favorite recipe or ANYTHING (like needlework) she may have taught you! Pastor Mary Beth may be leading during March discussing Tamar.

I will be ordering books and having them ready for you ahead. Or you could order yours from Presbyterianwomen.org (click on store). If you're only free in the evenings let me know and perhaps, we could plan for something at night.
