On June 15, 2022, Old Greenwich Presbyterian Church's Session (board of elders) updated our worship schedule and protocols to be:

- ♦ Masks are recommended indoors, but are optional for worship leaders, congregation, and small groups;
- Social distancing, as much as possible, is recommended in the sanctuary and other indoor spaces;
- ♦ Further, we strongly recommend:

(Additional precautions may be needed for people at high risk for severe illness.) While we remain a mask-optional church campus, the CDC recommends wearing masks as a precautionary measure while indoors while rates in our region remain high. We will have hand sanitizer and masks available to those who feel more comfortable wearing one. Anyone not feeling well should avoid large gatherings and remain at home to care for their own well-being. The health and safety of our church community are the responsibility of all.
