### MAKING ROOM FOR GOD

On February 22 – Ash Wednesday – we enter into our Lenten season. I love the season of Lent (I know; I *know*... I say that about every season of the church year!). But I really do love Lent. I love how it invites us to reflect honestly about where we are with God, with ourselves and with the rest of the world. I love how Lent invites us into prayer, into silence, and into relationship with the Holy One in new and different ways. In short, I love how Lent invites us to make room for God.

In the spirit of praying deeply – making room for God in new ways – you might notice that our Sunday morning worship services during the season of Lent will feel a little different than usual. Beginning on Sunday, February 26, and going through Sunday, March 26, our 10 am Sunday services will include a little less "talking" (especially from yours truly!), a little more music, and a little more silence. In addition to a bit more spacious Sunday morning service, we are also offering a prayer time from 9:45 to 10 am every Sunday (February 26 - March 26). All are welcome to this sacred space. We will meet in the old youth room (right next to the choir room) at 9:45. For 15 minutes or so before the worship service, we will sing simple hymns, listen to the Word, and allow for some breathing and silence together.

When we shift how we meet God, even just a little, we are allowing a space – actually, *opening* a space – in which God can work. If we do it regularly, we are slowly, very slowly, honing our listening skills. We might not even notice a difference at first – it's that slow. But if we keep opening up that space for God, and if we keep trying, keep listening, keep showing up, eventually, and sometimes to our surprise, God will have a word for us.

As we enter into our Lenten season, my prayer is that we might become a praying and listening people, even more so than we already are; that we would open ourselves up to God in new ways. My prayer is that we would make room.

Who knows what God might reveal?
