# ADVENT

Happy New Year! Happy *CHURCH* New Year, that is. On Sunday, December 3, the church year starts over with the season of Advent, a season of mystery, depth, darkness, and hope.

I've always loved the season of Advent. Growing up, my sister and I used to play with a nativity set for hours. We would march Mary and Joseph, the wise men, shepherds, animals, and even Baby Jesus all around our house from the kitchen to our bedrooms to the bathroom. They went on quite a journey!

As an adult, I realize that my sister and I understood something about the nature of Advent, even before we had the words to articulate it: Advent is all about movement. Advent is all about motion. Advent is all about God coming into this world – *breaking* into this world, really – as a small, helpless baby named Jesus.

During Advent, like those wise men, shepherds, and even animals, we are invited to go on a journey, too. Like them, we, too, are invited to *move* – to move into a deeper, more mysterious union with God. During Advent, we are invited to move past shallowness, materialism, and complacency, into the joy and wonder of worshipping our God-made-flesh, who comes to us as the vulnerable Christ child.

Towards that end of moving into the mysteries of the season, Elders Lisa Gray and Lisa Kolterjahn are leading an Advent study this season, open to the whole community. It will be held in the Prayer Room, at 7 pm each Wednesday, through December 20. The group will explore the book "Stay a While - Advent Lessons in Divine Hospitality," written by Kara Eidson. Each session stands alone, so even if you miss a few, you are still welcome to join in!

Our church is also offering a Longest Night (Blue Christmas) service for the journey, which will be held on Wednesday, December 20, at 7:30 pm. The whole community is welcome to this service, where we will honestly acknowledge our grief during this time of the year, all the while pointing to the hope we have in God. Please tell anyone you know who might be struggling at this time of year about this service, as we do not all feel "happy-clappy" during this season.

We are looking forward to meeting you at this holy, tender, and often difficult time, as we draw closer and closer to the Christ child, our God-made-flesh.

And, during this season of Advent, may God bless us as we move, deepen, grieve, wonder, and grow.
